

Parking Information



Parking will be available inside the cemetery.

Please enter through the <u>MAIN GATE</u> of the Cemetery and you will be directed to the designated parking areas. An information booklet will be given to you at the gate and you will need to put on your wristband. *We would appreciate it if tour goers NOT enter through the east entrances.*

Parking is only allowed on **one side** of the interior streets unless otherwise indicated by the parking attendants. Please follow the posted parking signs and parking attendant directions. Thank you!

So, What is a Cemetery Tour?

So, what is a Cemetery Tour? This event features actors performing a living history presentation of real men and women who lived in North Platte. The ghosts on this year's tour are murderers or victims of murder! Some of the crimes revealed on this tour are still unsolved.

WARNING! Suitability for Children

This is a historical cemetery tour. History can be scary, painful, sad, and hard to understand at times. The Murder & Mayhem in the Midwest tour includes such history *and may not be appropriate for young children*.

Informational Booklet

All ticket holders will receive a complimentary *Cemetery Tour Booklet* when they present their ticket at the ticket gate or attend the special non-walking performance. This booklet provides basic information and background on the "ghosts" on the tour, as well as a map to assist in locating the "ghosts" on the walking tour.

Tour Car and Bottled Water

There will be a car driving around the Cemetery while the walking tour is taking place. Flag down the car for emergencies or if you need a ride back to your car because you are fatigued. The car will also be carrying bottled water that will be given to anyone who needs it.

Seating at graveside & chair information

Limited Seating (6 chairs) will be available around each actor. *You are encouraged to bring a portable chair with you on the walking tours, if you are able.* Most of the "ghost" monologues are 10 minutes in length and you may wish to sit during some of the longer performances.



Ticket Information

Blue (adult) or Orange (child) wristbands are for the outdoor Cemetery Tours held at the North Platte Cemetery on either Friday or Saturday. *Wristbands MUST be worn during the tours at the North Platte Cemetery.*

Special paper tickets will be issued to persons wishing to attend the nonwalking tour. <u>This paper ticket is REQUIRED for admittance into the</u> <u>non-walking tour and must be presented on Tuesday evening.</u>

Lost tickets cannot be replaced for free or re-issued.

Advance Tickets are \$10.00 for adults; and \$5.00 for children (ages 5-15). Tickets may be purchased at the North Platte Public Library, 120 W 4th St, North Platte NE 69101.

Gate/Door tickets are \$15.00; and \$5.00 for children (ages 5-15) Gate/Door tickets will be available at the venue (North Platte Cemetery or Quality Inn & Suites-non-walking tour). Purchase your tickets early and save a little money!

YIKES, I forgot! Can I attend another performance on a different day?

If you forget to attend the Friday walking tour, you are welcome to attend the Saturday tour. However, you will still need to bring and wear your green and white wristband on the Saturday tour.

If you are unable to attend either Friday and Saturday performance and hold an outdoor wristband, you will need to come to the North Platte Public Library to exchange your wristband for a paper non-walking ticket. The non-walking tour audience is limited to 150 seats. Exchange is only possible if there are still tickets available.

How long does the tour take?

The tour takes approximately 2 hours. The tour is self-guided and you choose the order in which you visit each of the actors.
