

WHO CAN COMPETE

The Adult Divisions are open to anyone 15 years of age and up. Students, grades 2 through 8 should be participating in the student division; however, families wanting to compete in the 4-person adult division are allowed to have younger members if desired.

PUZZLE INFORMATION

- © Four (4) person adult teams will be piecing together identical 750 piece puzzles
- © Two (2) person adult teams will be piecing together identical 500 piece puzzles.
- © Individual adult competition will be piecing together identical 300 piece puzzles.

! NEW IN 2018 ! MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TEAMS PER DIVISION

In 2018, there will be a maximum number of teams accepted into each division due to the limited space available for the Jigsaw Puzzle Tournament. The break down for maximum teams per division is six 4-person adult teams, fifteen 2-person adult teams, and five in the individual competition.

WINNERS

Winners will be determined within each division through the following methods:

- A. Places are determined by puzzle completion in the shortest amount of time.
- B. If puzzles are not completed in allotted time, then the order of places (1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.) will be determined by Tournament Judges based on a count of the remaining pieces and connected sections.

PRIZES – ADULT DIVISIONS

- C The 1st place through 4th place team members in the 4-Person Adult and 2-Person Adult team divisions will be given a custom tote bag. The 1st place in the Individual division will be given a custom tote bag.
- © Fifth place team members in the 4-Person Adult team divisions will be given a Puzzle Tournament Tumbler. Fifth through 8th place in the 2-person division and 2nd-3rd places in the Individual Division will be given a Puzzle tumbler.

ENTRY FEE – ALL DIVISIONS

The North Platte Public Library Foundation Board will be finding local businesses to provide sponsors for puzzlers wanting to participate and compete. However, this tournament is a fundraising event for the Library Foundation and any donations towards the cost of putting on this tournament are greatly appreciated. Donations for the tournament will be taken through **March 31, 2018** and the Library can invoice you if that is helpful.
